

Amateur course record for Harradine

Michael Harradine followed an opening 66 with a 74 in the Club Championship to post a winning tally of 5-under par for the tournament and also set an amateur course record in the process.

He produced an unbelievable 7-under par 66 over the Faldo course that included no less than eight birdies and one dropped shot on the 17th, the tough 218-yard par three. This was an amateur course record from the Blue stones of the Faldo layout measuring 6,868 yards.

He took an 8-shot lead into the final round over the Majlis from Pontus Fredriksson, the defending champion. Harradine continued his consistent display and only dropped one shot on the opening nine of the Majlis to maintain a 7-shot lead over Fredriksson. Harradine returned in 38 strokes to post a 74 and 140 tally overall.

Fredriksson settled for the runner-up place with scores of 74 and 75, a brave defence of his title. Sheikh Rashid champion Daniel Hendry clinched third with rounds of 79 and 72, edging out Ewan Cameron into fourth after a 75 and 76.
